

# Announcement of Quota Admission Bachelor of Science in Engineering and Technology Management Academic Year 2017

## International College, King Mongkut's Institute of Technology Ladkrabang

The International College, King Mongkut's Institute of Technology Ladkrabang, invites qualified applicants to apply for admission to the **Bachelor of Science Program in Engineering and Technology Management (International Program)** in Academic Year 2017 (starting in August 2017). This round of admission is open to all students who have excellent academic records and satisfy the requirements set out in Section 1 below. Selection of the qualified candidates for this round of admission is based on the applicant' academic records, standardized test scores, and an interview. If qualified, applicants may also apply for the **International College Undergraduate Scholarships**. Requirements for scholarship applicants can be found in Section 2.

## 1. Applicant qualifications

The applicant is required to meet the requirements specified in section 1.1, 1.2, and 1.3 below.

## 1.1 Educational background

The applicant must satisfy one of the following requirements:

- a) Graduated or studying in Mathayom 6.
- b) Graduated or studying in the final year of a 12-Year or 13-Year education in an international school in Thailand or in a high school/secondary school abroad.
- c) Graduated or studying in the final year of a vocational program in a college in Thailand or abroad where the primary language of instruction is English, and obtained (or expected to obtain prior to the start of Academic Year 2017) a qualification equivalent to Mathayom 6 or higher.
- d) Obtained (or expected to obtain prior to the start of Academic Year 2017) a qualification equivalent to Mathayom 6 as approved by the Ministry of Education of Thailand.

## 1.2 Academic records

The applicant should possess an excellent academic record which, at the minimum, meets the requirements specified in 1.2.1 or 1.2.2 or 1.2.3:

1.2.1 The applicant's combined grade point average for all courses in **mathematics** as recorded in the applicant's latest academic transcript is no less than 3.0 in 4.0 scale (or equivalent).

1.2.2 The applicant has taken at least <u>one of the following standardized tests</u> and obtained a score which meets the minimum requirement specified:

1.2.3 Pass the qualification examination on mathematics administered by the International College. The exam covers the topics tested in SAT Mathematics Level 1 subject test, which include: number and operations, algebra and functions, geometry and measurement (plane Euclidean geometry, coordinate, conic section, and trigonometry), data analysis, statistics and probability.

## 1.3 English language requirements

The applicant should possess good skills of English which, at the minimum, meets the requirements specified in <u>1.3.1 or 1.3.2 or 1.3.3</u>:

1.3.1 The applicant has obtained <u>one of the following test scores</u> and meets the minimum requirement specified:

1.3.2 Pass the qualification examination on English language administered by the International College. The exam evaluates the applicant's academic reading and writing skills of English.

1.3.3 The applicant has been studying for two years or longer in a school or a college in which the primary language of instruction is English.

# 2. International College Undergraduate Scholarships

The International College is offering two types of scholarships for undergraduate students, each with a limited number of awards. The number of awards, the eligibility conditions, and the terms and conditions of each type of scholarships are as summarized in the following table. Note that application for scholarships is <u>optional</u>; please indicate on the (on-line) application for admission whether to apply for scholarships or not.

## 3. Number of acceptances

The International College expects to accept 50 applicants from this round of admission. The International College may accept a lower or greater number depending on the total number of qualified applicants.

### 4. Tuition fee

The tuition fee for the students entering the program in Academic Year 2017 is 75,000 THB per semester. This fee does <u>not</u> cover the cost of optional overseas training and the cost of textbooks.

## 6. Application submission

The application can be made <u>free-of-charge</u>. Please follow the steps below to prepare and submit an application.

- 2) If you wish to apply for a scholarship, specify which type of scholarships to apply and complete the accompanying scholarship application form.

- 3) Prepare the supporting documents listed below. Please include your name and your Application ID number on each document submitted.
  - a) A copy of the applicant's national identification card or passport
  - b) A copy of the applicant's name-change certificate (if any)
  - c) Latest academic transcript

If the applicant has already graduated, an official final transcript should be submitted. Otherwise, the latest official transcript available at the time the application is made should be submitted.

d) Standardized-test score reports (if required)

A copy of the score report for each applicable standardized test should be sent. However, in case a score report is not available at the time the application is made, the applicant must indicate in his/her application form which test the applicant is waiting for the result, and then send the score report to the International College once the test result becomes available.

e) An academic portfolio (if any)

An academic portfolio and any additional supporting document may be included with the application, or brought to the interview and presented to the examiners.

- 3) Submit the supporting documents by one of the following methods:
  - a) Scan the documents and upload the files onto the online application system. This must be done after creating a new online application but before submitting the application.
