



Announcement
2018 Undergraduate Admission - TCAS Round 5
International College, King Mongkut's Institute of Technology Ladkrabang

The International College, King Mongkut's Institute of Technology Ladkrabang, has called for applications for undergraduate admission in Round 5 of the Thai University Central Admission System (TCAS) 2018. Application requirements and procedure are as detailed below.

1. Programs and expected number of acceptances

Program	Number of acceptances in this round*
Bachelor of Science in Engineering and Technology Management (International Program)	25
Bachelor of Engineering in Software Engineering (International Program)	10

* The International College may accept a lower or greater number depending on the number of qualified applicants.

2. Applicant qualifications

The applicant is required to meet the requirements specified in section 2.1 and 2.2 below.

2.1 General requirement

The applicant must be a Thai national who have graduated (or are expected to graduate before the start of Academic Year 2018) from a high school (or equivalent) in Thailand or abroad.

2.2 Specific requirement

2.2.1 Engineering and Technology Management

The applicant of the Engineering and Technology Management program is required to take and pass both of the following paper-based examinations administered by the International College:

- Qualification examination on mathematics, covering the topics tested in SAT Mathematics Level 1 subject test, which include: number and operations, algebra and functions, geometry and measurement (plane Euclidean geometry, coordinate, conic section, and trigonometry), data analysis, statistics and probability
- English language proficiency test, which assesses the applicant's academic reading and writing skills of English.

The applicant who has been studying for two years or longer in a school or a college outside Thailand in which the primary language of instruction is English is exempted from taking the English language proficiency test.

2.2.2 Software Engineering

The applicant of the Software Engineering program is required to submit the scores for one of the standardized tests of mathematics and one of the English language proficiency tests set out below that meet the minimum requirements specified. Note that only a score report which is valid (i.e. not expired) on the day of the interview will be considered.

- Mathematical standardized test (at least one of the following)

- English language proficiency test (at least one of the following)

TU-GET	500
GAT (Part 2 - English)	75

The applicant who has been studying for two years or longer in a school or a college outside Thailand in which the primary language of instruction is English is exempted from submitting the English language proficiency test score.

3. Tuition fee

The tuition fee for the students entering the program in Academic Year 2018 is 75,000 THB per semester. This fee does not cover the cost of optional overseas training and the cost of textbooks.
