Bachelor of Business Administration (International Program), Academic Year 2020

King Mongkut's Institute of Technology Ladkrabang

The Faculty of Administration and Management, King Mongkut's Institute of Technology Ladkrabang, is calling for applicants to its 2020 international undergraduate program. This round of admission is open for Thai high school students internationally or locally based including those that fall under an existing MOU with the institute.

1. Programs of study and Number of admitted students

The Faculty of Administration and Management accepts applications for admission for the Academic Year 2020 for the following undergraduate program:

- Bachelor of Business Administration (International Program)

The number of admitted students in the Quota Admission (Round 2) is 50 students.

2. Applicant qualifications

Applicants for the Quota Admission (Round 2) are required to meet the following requirements.

The applicant is studying in or has obtained a high school (Matthayom 6) diploma from a school in Thailand or overseas.

2.1) The applicant is studying in or has obtained (or is expected to obtain prior to the start of Academic Year 2020) a qualification equivalent to a high school diploma (English Program, MEP, IEP, or any other program conducted in English). The applicant's GPAX is not required as the main criteria for admission.

2.2) The applicant is studying for or has obtained (or is expected to obtain prior to the start of Academic Year 2020) a qualification equivalent to a high school diploma from an international school, as approved by the Ministry of Education of Thailand. The applicant's GPAX is not required as the main criteria for admission.

2.3) The applicant is studying for or has obtained (or is expected to obtain prior to the start of Academic Year 2020) a qualification equivalent to a high school diploma from a school overseas where English is the language of instruction as in the United States of America, Australia, The United Kingdom, or any other countries with an English education system. The applicant's GPAX is not required as the main criteria for admission.

2.4) The applicant is studying for or has obtained (or is expected to obtain prior to the start of Academic Year 2020) a qualification equivalent to a high school diploma in a Science-Math,

English-Math, or Language-Arts Program with mathematical skills - having a GPAX of 2.50 or above from a school in Thailand with one of the criteria stated below:

2.4.1 The applicant should have experience in an exchange program as an exchange student in a country where English is an official language.

2.4.2 If the applicant does not have experience in an exchange program as an exchange student in a country where English is an official language, the applicant should have experience in an international multicultural activity, for example, a cultural exchange program, an English competition, a family business with international trades, experience from living overseas, or a notable skill such as public speaking in English or any other remarkable performance in this aspect.

2.4.3 The applicant must submit at least one Standardized English test result such as GAT (Part 2-English), CU-TEP, TU-GET, IELTS, TOEFL (iBT), or any other Standardized English test which is equivalent and comparable to one of the English tests aforementioned. Only a score report which is valid (i.e. not expired) will be taken into consideration on the day of the interview.

2.4.4 The applicant has graduated from schools that fall under an existing MOU with the institute, demonstration schools, or from a school ranked within the top 100. In addition, applicants must have the necessary knowledge and English language skills.

Other qualifications

The interview committee will consider applicants who provide evidence of English proficiency and/or mathematics test scores as a plus.

**** Please take note that the applicant must satisfy one of the qualifications above and present it to the committee at the interview. ****

Essential qualifications

1. The applicant must be under the Domestic form of Government with the King as the Head of the State.
2. The applicant shall be physically and mentally healthy.
3. The applicant must demonstrate good behavior and a good attitude toward their studies and strictly conform to the institute's rules and regulations.
4. The applicant should not have been expelled from any other institute because of improper manner or misconduct.
5. The applicant must be authorized to stay in Thailand legally.
6. The applicant should not have been punished in accordance with corruption in any exam.
7. The applicant should not have been dismissed from an institute because of liabilities.

- English proficiency
- Determination to pursue the Business Administration Degree (International Program)
- Personality and Etiquette suitability for the program

6. Announcement of Admissions

The Faculty of Administration and Management, King Mongkut's Institute of Technology Ladkrabang, holds the right to select eligible and qualified applicants. The announcement of accepted students will be posted at the Office of the Registrar at <http://www.reg.kmitl.ac.th>.

7. Confirmation of Student Status and Payment of Tuition Fees

Applicants who have been accepted for enrollment (Clearing House) and have had their names announced for admission at King Mongkut's Institute of Technology Ladkrabang, shall confirm their desire to be a student via <http://www.reg.kmitl.ac.th> and pay their confirmation payment within the 30th of April to the 5th May 2020. Non-confirmation and/or any avoidance of any process may result in disqualification. Any payment, application fee and/or confirmation payment, made by the applicants are non-refundable.

8. Disqualification

8.1) Accepted applicants who have not yet confirmed enrollment (Clearing House) within the specified time will be considered disqualified.

8.2) Accepted applicants who have not yet confirmed enrollment (online) and have not made the payment within the specified time, will be considered disqualified.

8.3) Accepted applicants who have not yet obtained a high school diploma prior to the start of Academic Year 2020 will be considered disqualified.

9. Tuition Fees

Qualified applicants accepted as students of the Faculty of Administration and Management must make a payment of 40,000 Baht per semester. Please note that the application payment is non-refundable.

In the case that the applicant has submitted any forged documents or have been found non-compliant to the qualification requirements, the committee will immediately disqualify the applicant. The committee's judgment for the admission result of the Faculty of Administration and Management will be considered and deemed final.
