The International Academy of Aviation Industry invites qualified applicants to apply for admission to the following undergraduate programs in the Academic Year 2021 (beginning in August 2021). This round of admission is provided to all applicant's with excellent academic backgrounds. Selection criteria of qualified candidates are based on the applicant's academic records, standardized test scores, and English proficiency test results, along with a personal statement, letters of recommendation, past academic-related activities, an on-site interview, and other supplementary documents.

**1. Programs and Number of Acceptances**

The International Academy of Aviation Industry may accept a lower or greater number of candidates depending on the total number of qualified applicants.

**2. Qualification criteria:**

**2.1 Educational background**

The applicant must satisfy at least one of the following requirements:

- 1) Graduated from or studying in Matthayom 6 or equivalent.
- 2) Graduated from or studying in the final year of grade 12 or grade 13 at an accredited school or higher-education institution in Thailand or abroad.

The applicant must provide an official final transcript and official high school diploma and or certificates of completion from their school before the start of Academic Year 2021.

3) Having no condition that blocks physical mobility or has adverse effect on study. Applicants must be able to read and write.

### 2.2 Academic Records

The applicant has to meet **ONE** of the following requirements.

2.2.1 The applicant has taken at least one of the following standardized test results and obtain a score which meets the minimum requirements as specified in the following table:

2.2.2 The applicant that has not taken standardized tests in 2.2.1 must take written examination issued by the International Academy of Aviation Industry on the interview date.

**Remark:** If the applicant cannot fulfill the above requirements before the semester starts, he or she will be required to enroll in an additional English as a Second Language (ESL) course and Mathematics preparation course at the International Academy of Aviation Industry, KMITL before August 2021 (Additional fees will apply)

## 4. Scholarship offered for Selected Applicants in Logistics Management Program

### 4.1 Scholarship detail

Full scholarships (exempt of tuition fee of 90,000 baht), half scholarships (exempt of tuition fee of 45,000 baht), and quarter scholarships (exempt of tuition fee of 22,500 baht) for 8 academic semesters (excluding summer semesters) are available. All applicants are eligible for scholarship consideration.

### 4.2 Selection

Selection criteria and scholarship grant is based on applicant's academic records, standardized Mathematics and English tests, statement of purpose, extra-curricular activities, and interview.

IAAI holds the right to grant scholarships to selected applicants. The decisions made by the program committee cannot be overruled.

### 4.3 Requirements

#### 4.3.1 Academic records

The applicant's combined grade point average as recorded in the applicant's academic transcript is no less than 3.00 in 4.00 scale (or equivalent).

#### 4.3.2 Other Proficiencies

##### (1) Mathematics proficiency

(1.1) The application has a grade point average of all mathematics at high school level of more than 70% or 3.00 (from A to F grading system) **OR**

(1.2) The applicant has taken at one of the following standardized Mathematics tests and obtained a score which meet the minimum requirement specified:

(1.3) The applicant has the at least 75% of Mathematics written examination score.

(2) English proficiency

(2.1) The applicant has a grade point average of all mathematics at high school level of more than 70% or 3.00 (from A to F grading system) OR has obtained a score which meet the minimum requirement specified:

(2.2) The applicant has the at least 80% of English proficiency written examination score.

**\*All scores must be valid on the day of the interview.**

4.3.3 Statement of purpose indicating applicant's motivation to study and goal, with a minimum length of 300 words (Font size 14 Times New Roman) and not exceeding 1 A4 sized sheet of paper.

4.3.4 Achievements, academic or honorary awards (if available)

#### **4.4 Conditions**

4.4.1 Scholarship recipients must obtain grade point score (GPS) of 3.25 or higher in the first semester of study and maintain grade point average (GPA) of 3.25 or higher throughout the period of study (not exceeding 4 years). Grade point score in every semester must be at least 3.00. Grade point score in summer semester will not be considered.

4.4.2 The scholarship recipients must not fail (receive F) in any subject.

4.4.3 The scholarship recipients must follow academic regulations and possess good behavior.

4.4.4 The scholarship recipients are required to work for and support IAAI's extra-curricular activities for at least 40 hours per semester.

#### **5. Application Submission**

The applicant will be notified of his/her eligibility for an on-site interview after the admission committee reviews the applications. The actual location and time of the interview will be announced before the interview date.

The applicant must apply online and upload all necessary documents via our online application system: <https://new.reg.kmitl.ac.th/admission/#/> The applicant must deposit a 1,000 THB (one thousand Thai Baht only) non-refundable application fee using the specified payment methods announced at the online application system. The applicant is responsible for any additional transaction fee incurred by financial institutions. If the applicant does not reside in Thailand, please contact our IAAI admissions office to facilitate the application process.

The applicant will be notified of his/her eligibility for an on-site interview after the admissions committee reviews the application. The actual location and time of the interview will be announced before the interview date mentioned above.



## **6. Tuition Fees and Enrollment Confirmation**

The paid tuition fee is non-refundable and cannot be reimbursed under any circumstances. The tuition fees for Academic Year 2021 are as follows:

The tuition fees for students in **Bachelor of Science in Logistics Management** is 90,000 THB (ninety thousand Thai Baht only) per semester (excluding the cost of living on campus, cost of overseas training, and cost of textbooks). The fee must be paid to KMITL, posted at [www.reg.kmitl.ac.th](http://www.reg.kmitl.ac.th).

## **7. Confirmation of Admission Offer through TCAS Clearing House and Confirmation of Enrollment**

Accepted applicants must follow the procedure to confirm their admission offer through the TCAS64 Clearing House as required by the Council of University Presidents of Thailand. After confirming their admission offer, the applicants must confirm their enrollment at KMITL and pay the tuition fee according to the procedure announced on the website: [www.reg.kmitl.ac.th](http://www.reg.kmitl.ac.th). The tuition fee paid is non-refundable under any circumstances. The applicants who have confirmed their enrollment at KMITL, and have paid the tuition fee can enroll and register for courses in Semester 1/2021 without having to pay the tuition fee for Semester 1/2021 again.

## 8. Disqualification

8.1 The applicants who previously confirmed the acceptance of an offer on the TCAS64 Clearing House will not be allowed to confirm another admission offer on the TCAS64 Clearing House unless their previous confirmation has been completely withdrawn within the specified period.

8.2 The accepted applicants who do not confirm the admission offer through the TCAS64 Clearing House or do not confirm their enrollment at KMITL and pay of the tuition fee according to the specified procedure and within the specified period will be disqualified from admission into the program.

8.3 The applicants who are unable to provide proof of Matthayom 6 graduation or qualification that the admission committee considers equivalent to Matthayom 6 before Semester 1/2021 begins, the applicant will be disqualified from admission into the program.
