Third Round of Direct Admission

Bachelor of Science in Architecture (International Program)

Academic Year 2021, The Faculty of Architecture

King Mongkut's Institute of Technology Ladkrabang (KMITL)

Architectural Intelligence and Design Thinking (AIDT), Faculty of Architecture, King Mongkut's Institute of Technology Ladkrabang invites qualified applicants to apply for admission to the Bachelor of Science in Architecture program for Academic Year 2021 (beginning in August 2021). This round of admission is open to all applicants with excellent academic backgrounds. The selection of qualified candidates is based on the applicant's academic records, standardized test scores, and English proficiency test results, along with a personal statement, letters of recommendation, past academic activities, an on-site interview, and other supplementary documents.

1. Number of Acceptances

25 persons.

Note: The Faculty of Architecture may accept a lower or greater number depending on the total number of qualified applicants.

2. Qualifications

2.1 Educational background

The applicant must satisfy at least one of the following requirements:

2.1.1 Graduated from or studying in Matthayom 6 or equivalent.

2.1.2 Graduated from or studying in the final year of grade 12 (US system) or grade 13 (British/IB system) at an accredited college or higher-education institution in Thailand or abroad.

2.1.3 Obtained or expected to receive a qualification equivalent to Matthayom 6, or passed the high school equivalent standard test [GED, GCE 'A' Level], as approved by the Ministry of Education before the start of Academic Year 2021.

2.1.4 The applicant must possess a history of good behavior and agree to abide strictly by existing and future KMITL regulations, codes, and policies.

Remark:

For American System,

- General Educational Development (GED) Credential obtained before May 2017 with a minimum total score 2250 on all 5 subjects and at least 410 points on each subject, **or**
- General Educational Development (GED) Credential obtained after May 2017 with minimum score of 145 on all 4 subjects and all 4 subjects having a "pass".

For the British System,

- International General Certificate of Secondary Education (IGCSE), **or** General Certificate of Secondary Education (GCSE), **or** General Certificate of Education Ordinary Level (GCE O Level), with grade results A*-C on 5 different subjects + transcript.
- **And** General Certificate of Education Advanced Level (GCE A-Level) with grade results A*-E on at least 3 different subjects + transcript.

2.2 Application Requirements

2.2.1 Two one-inch (1") photographs and a copy of your Thai citizen ID card or a copy of your passport pages.

2.2.2 Academic transcript(s); and in the case of high school completion, a copy of your Diploma from the school must also be submitted. In the case of currently being in the final year of high school, a copy of an official document certifying academic status from the applicant's school is also required.

2.2.3 The applicant must submit their test score from at least one of the following English proficiency tests.

*English proficiency test scores must be no older than two years (submit at least one)

Remark: If the applicant cannot fulfill the above requirement, he or she will be required to enroll in additional English as a Second Language (ESL) courses at KMITL, after admission to the AIDT program.

2.2.4 The applicant must submit a test score for at least one of the following Math tests (choose one).

CU-AAT (Math) 550

SAT (Math) 570

Mathematics on NCEA (New Zealand) Merit or Excellence

Level Another internationally accredited standardized tests.

Remark: If the applicant cannot fulfill the above requirement, he or she will be required to enroll in additional Mathematics at KMITL, after admission to the program. The decision made by the AIDT Committee is deemed final.

2.2.5 Personal Statement: Please submit a self-written essay (650 words or less) that demonstrates your ability to communicate your thoughts and your related experience(s) in the field of study within the online application.

2.2.6 Two Recommendation Letters: the applicant should upload PDF or JPG snapshots of the letters of recommendation documents issued by academic advisors or teachers.

2.2.7 Portfolio: Personal works of art, craft, design, etc. collated into one A4 size folder or binding with thickness not more than one inch. The portfolio must only contain works created by the applicant; plagiarized information or work is not accepted and may lead to disqualification.

Remark: Portfolio; the purpose of the portfolio is to demonstrate the applicant's abilities as well as his / her organizational skills. The portfolio must demonstrate versatility in different medias such as sketching, painting, and photography. Architectural perspectives are not compulsory but will further reflect the applicant's skill of understanding the subject of architecture. Attention should be paid to the quality of the reproduction. If original works are referenced, however, it is favored that applicants photograph the subject and create drawn media, via this method.

4. Application Submission

The applicant must apply online and upload all necessary documents via our online application system: <https://new.reg.kmitl.ac.th/admission/> The applicant must deposit a 500-baht non-refundable application fee using the specified payment methods in the application system. The applicant is responsible for any additional transaction fee incurred by financial institutions. If the applicant does not reside in Thailand, please contact our AIDT admission office to facilitate the application process.

The applicant will be notified of his/her eligibility for an on-site interview after the admissions committee reviews the application. The actual location and time of the interview will be announced prior to the interview date.

All submitted documents in Section 2.2 Application Requirements (pdf format), must be submitted to aidt.archkmitl@gmail.com no later than **Monday, 31 May 2021** (unofficial transcripts or examination test scores can be submitted); please bring the original documents to the interview.

- A photocopy of the applicant's national identification card or passport
- Academic Records - High School Transcript, SAT, ACT, IB, GED, etc.
- English Proficiency Test score - IELTS, TOEFL, etc.
- Two recommendation letters from teachers or supervisors (can be sealed and sent via email or posted by your school)
- Portfolios: provide a link to your portfolios or submit in the form of a pdf attached with your email to aidt.archkmitl@gmail.com. The applicant must bring their portfolios to the interview.
- Placement test results: submit available AP, IB Higher Level, A-Level, or any grade 12 equivalent placement test results. The policy and criteria for placement credits will be determined before the applicant's enrollment.
- Certificate of participation in any academic activities provided by Faculty of Architecture – KMITL

5. Tuition Fees and Enrollment Confirmation

The tuition fees for students entering the program in Academic Year 2021 are as follows: 92,500 THB per Semester
