KMITL Business School, King Mongkut's Institute of Technology Ladkrabang, is calling for applicants to apply to its 2022 international undergraduate program. Candidate selection through Direct Admission is based on the following criteria:

1. Programs of Study and Number of Admissions

The KMITL Business School accepts applications for the Academic Year 2022 for the following undergraduate program:

- Bachelor of Business Administration (International Program)

All the teaching and learning activities in the program are conducted in English. For details of the program, please visit: <http://www.kbs.kmitl.ac.th/home>

The number of admissions accepted from this round is **30 students**.

2. Applicant Qualifications

Applicants for the Direct Admission are required to meet the following requirements specified below:

The applicant is studying for or has obtained a high school (Matthayom 6) diploma from a school in Thailand or overseas.

Applicants must satisfy one of the following requirements:

2.1) The applicant is studying for or has obtained (or is expected to obtain prior to the start of Academic Year 2022) a qualification equivalent to a high school diploma (English Program, MEP, IEP, or any other program conducted in English). The applicant's GPAX is not required as the main criteria for admission.

2.2) The applicant is studying for or has obtained (or is expected to obtain prior to the start of Academic Year 2022) a qualification equivalent to a high school diploma from an international school, as approved by the Ministry of Education of Thailand. The applicant's GPAX is not required as the main criteria for admission.

2.3) The applicant is studying for or has obtained (or is expected to obtain prior to the start of Academic Year 2022) a qualification equivalent to a high school diploma from a school overseas where English is the language of instruction as in the United States of America, Australia, the United Kingdom, or any other countries with an English education system. The applicant's GPAX is not required as the main criteria for admission.

2.4) The applicant is studying for or has obtained (or is expected to obtain prior to the start of Academic Year 2022) a qualification equivalent to a high school diploma in a Science-Math, English-Math, or Language-Arts Program with mathematical skills - having a GPAX of 2.50 or above from a school in Thailand with one of the criteria stated below:

2.4.1 The applicant should have experience in an exchange program as an exchange student in a country where English is an official language.

2.4.2 If the applicant does not have experience in an exchange program as an exchange student in a country where English is an official language, the applicant should have experience in an international multicultural activity, for example, a cultural exchange program, an English competition, a family business with international trades, the experience of living overseas, or a notable skill such as public speaking in English or any other remarkable performance in this aspect.

2.4.3 The applicant must submit at least one Standardized English test result such as GAT (Part 2-English), CU-TEP, TU-GET, IELTS, TOEFL (iBT), or any other Standardized English test which is equivalent and comparable to one of the English tests mentioned. Only a valid score report (i.e. not expired) will be taken into consideration on the day of the interview.

2.5) The applicant must complete the GED program. The applicant can submit a GED (with at least 145 on each test subject) as an equivalent of having studied at high school for the interview committee's consideration.

Portfolio

The applicant must satisfy one of the qualification requirements and make a portfolio presentation to the committee on the interview day, presenting notable skills such as information technology skills, musical/athletic talents, cross-cultural performance, etc.

Essential qualifications

1. The applicant must be under the Domestic form of Government with the King as the Head of the State.
2. The applicant shall be physically and mentally healthy.
3. The applicant must demonstrate good behavior and a good attitude toward their studies and strictly conform to the institute's rules and regulations.
4. The applicant should not have been expelled from any other institute because of improper manner or misconduct.
5. The applicant must be authorized to stay in Thailand legally.
6. The applicant should not have been punished for corruption in any exam.
7. The applicant should not have been dismissed from the institute because of liabilities.

- The applicant's qualifications
- Other qualifications as described on the application form
- English proficiency
- Determination to pursue the Business Administration Degree (International Program)
- Personality and Etiquette suitability for the program

*** The judgment of the committee is final. ***

6. Announcement of Admissions

The KMITL Business School, King Mongkut's Institute of Technology Ladkrabang, holds the right to select eligible and qualified applicants. The announcement of accepted students will be by the Office of the Registrar at: <https://new.reg.kmitl.ac.th/admission/>

7. Confirmation of Student Status and Payment of Tuition Fees

Applicants who have been accepted for enrollment with the clearinghouse right and have had their names announced for admission right into King Mongkut's Institute of Technology Ladkrabang, shall confirm their desire to be a student via <https://new.reg.kmitl.ac.th/admission/> and pay their confirmation payment (the tuition fee for the first semester) according to the announcement of the institute on the payment eligibility confirmation to attend King Mongkut's Institute of Technology Ladkrabang dated March 2, 2012. If the applicants have not made this payment to confirm their admission rights by the specified time, it will be taken that their admission rights are canceled.

In the case that the applicants have already reported themselves to the Institute via the Internet and paid the admission fee but, later on, wish to cancel their admission rights, the Institute will not refund the fee under any circumstances.

After the applicants have confirmed their intentions to be admitted into the Institute and has already paid the admission fee, they will not have to pay any lump-sum tuition fee for the first semester. The admission fee payment covers the lump-sum tuition fee payment for that semester.

8. Disqualification

8.1) Accepted applicants who have not yet confirmed enrollment (Clearing House) within the specified time will be considered disqualified.

8.2) Accepted applicants who have not yet confirmed enrollment (online) and have not made the payment within the specified time, will be considered disqualified.

8.3) Accepted applicants who have not yet obtained a high school diploma before the start of Academic Year 2022 will be considered disqualified.

9. Tuition Fees

Qualified applicants accepted as students of the KMITL Business School must make a payment of 40,000 Baht per semester. Please note that the application payment is non-refundable.

In the case that the applicant has submitted any forged documents or found non-compliant to the qualification requirements, the committee will immediately disqualify the applicant. The committee's judgment for the admission result of the KMITL Business School will considered and deemed final.
