School of Science, King Mongkut's Institute of Technology Ladkrabang (KMITL) invites qualified applicants to apply for admission into the Bachelor of Industrial and Engineering Chemistry (IEC) program for Academic Year 2022 (beginning in August 2022). This admission is open to all applicants with an educational background in science. The selection of qualified candidates is based on the applicant's academic records, standardized test scores, English proficiency test results, on-site or online interviews, and other supplementary documents.

1. Programs and Number of Acceptances

The Bachelor of Industrial and Engineering Chemistry (IEC) (International Program) offers three tracks of study:

Track 1: Two degrees: a Bachelor's Degree in Industrial and Engineering Chemistry (IEC) from KMITL and a Bachelor's Degree in Applied Chemistry from the University of Strathclyde (UoS, UK)

Track 2: a Bachelor's Degree in Industrial and Engineering Chemistry (IEC) from KMITL and a certificate of higher education in Applied Chemistry from the University of Strathclyde (UoS, UK)

Track 3: a Bachelor's Degree in Industrial and Engineering Chemistry (IEC) from KMITL

All the teaching and learning activities in the program are conducted in English. For more details, please visit www.inter.science.kmitl.ac.th

Admission is available for 20 students. The school of Science may accept a lower or greater number of acceptances depending on the number of qualified applicants.

2. Applicant Qualifications

2.1 Educational Background

The applicant must satisfy at least one of the following requirements:

1. Graduated from or studying in Matthayom 6 or equivalent.
2. Graduated from or studying in the final year of grade 12 (US system) or grade 13 (British/IB system) at an accredited college or higher-education institution in Thailand or abroad.
3. Obtained or expected to receive a qualification equivalent to Matthayom 6, or passed a high school equivalent standard test, as approved by the Ministry of Education before the start of Academic Year 2022.
4. Obtained or expected to receive a certificate of General Educational Development (GED) Credential with a minimum score of 145 on all 4 subjects.

The applicant must provide a final official transcript and their official high school diplomas and/or certificates of completion from their school before the start of Academic Year 2022.

2.2 Academic Records

The applicant should submit at least one of the following standardized test results and obtain a score that meets the minimum requirement specified for one of the following:

- Cumulative GPA in high school (at least 4 semesters) in the class rank of 65th percentile, 2.50 out of 4, or one of the following scores:

or one or more of the following records:

- SAT general test score of 1020 or higher
- GSAT score of 1020 or higher
- ACT composite score of 19 or higher
- IB Diploma score of 28 or higher
- Any national higher education board exam result (such as A-Level, Gaokao, GAT/PAT)

that the admission committees consider equivalent to one of the above qualifications.

2.3 English Language Requirement

The applicant should submit at least one of the following English proficiency test scores and obtain a score that meets the minimum requirement as specified below:

IELTS	4.0
KMITL-TEP	B1
TOIEC	600
CUTEP	60

***Remark:**

1. The test score must not be two years older than the date of the application deadline.
2. English proficiency test results would be waived for those who graduated from an international school or EP program.
3. In the case that the applicant cannot fulfill any of the above English requirements, he or she is required to enroll in additional "English as a Second Language (ESL)" courses provided by KMITL in July 2022.

4. Application Submission

The applicant must apply online and upload all necessary documents via our online application system at "<https://new.reg.kmitl.ac.th/admission/>". The applicant must pay a non-refundable application fee (500 baht) using the specified payment methods in the application system. The applicant is responsible for any additional transaction fee incurred by financial institutions.

The applicant will be notified of his/her eligibility for an on-site or online interview after the admission committees review their application. The actual location and time of the interview will be announced before the interview date.

The applicant must provide academic records and English proficiency test scores for online submission. The applicant must bring the original documents of the following items to the interview.

- The applicant's national identification card or passport
- Official high school transcripts
- Academic Records - Cumulative GPA or SAT, ACT, IB, etc.
- English proficiency test score - IELTS, TOEFL, KMITL-TEP, etc.
- (optional) Two recommendation letters from teachers or supervisors can be sent via email (interchem-sci@kmitl.ac.th).
- (optional) A link to your portfolios or achievements in the multimedia information section of the application. The applicant may also bring their portfolios to the interview.
- (optional) Placement test results AP, IB Higher Level, A-Level, or any grade 12 equivalent placement test results. The policy and criteria for placement credits will be determined before the applicant's enrollment.
- Certificate of participation in any academic activities organized by KMITL

5. Tuition Fees

Qualified applicants accepted as students of the International Bachelor of Industrial and Engineering Chemistry Program must make a payment of 75,000 baht per semester. Please note that the application payment is non-refundable.

6. Scholarships

First year students with exceptional academic records are eligible to apply for the selection of Academic Excellence Scholarship to pursue their undergraduate education in the international programs at the School of Science, KMITL.
