Instructions for accepted students who intend to enroll at KMITL

Students who are eligible to enroll at KMITL as listed in the attachment must complete the following steps to confirm their enrollment:

1. Visit TCAS website to confirm your offer at <https://student.mytcas.com/> **February 6-7, 2024, otherwise your offer will be withdrawn.** Note that you must complete a user registration process before the confirmation of your offer.
2. Once the confirmation has been completed, visit <https://new.reg.kmitl.ac.th/admission/> on **February 14, 2024**, to see the instruction for payment process.
3. Visit <https://new.reg.kmitl.ac.th/admission/>. Fill in the required information. Make the payment for the first semester's tuition fee in advance, using the designated payment method. The tuition fee for 1/2024 semester is as follows.
 - Students of Bachelor of Fine Arts Program in Creative Arts and Curatorial Studies (International Program) School of Architecture, Art, and Design 92,500 Baht / semester. The student must pay **the tuition fee February 19-26, 2024.**

If the student does not confirm his/her enrollment online or the student's tuition fee has not been paid during the specified dates using the designated payment method, the student will forfeit his/her enrollment's right and will not be able to enroll at KMITL.

The institution does not accept any other form of payment and will not be responsible for any payment made using other methods or any payment made on dates other than the specified period. The payment is non-refundable under any circumstance. After the payment has been made, the institution will not refund nor reimburse the tuition fee and the student will not pursue legal action against the institution under any circumstance.

4. After the student has confirmed their enrollment and paid the tuition fee, he/she must prepare to proceed the matriculation process via KMITL Online Matriculation System in order to provide the required documents and register for semester 1/2024 to KMITL Registration and Educational Service Office. Additional information regarding the matriculation procedure will be announced by the KMITL Registration and Educational Service Office, KMITL.
