

# Announcement Direct Admission Round 2-1 Academic Year 2024 Bachelor of Science in Architecture (International Program) School of Architecture, Art, and Design King Mongkut's Institute of Technology Ladkrabang (KMITL)

School of Architecture, Art, and Design, King Mongkut's Institute of Technology Ladkrabang invites qualified applicants to apply for admission to the Bachelor of Science in Architecture program for the Academic Year 2024 (beginning in July 2024). This round of admission is open to all applicants with excellent academic backgrounds. The selection of qualified candidates is based on the applicant's academic records, standardized test scores, and English proficiency test results, along with a personal statement, letters of recommendation, past academic activities, an on-site interview, and other supplementary documents.

# 1. Number of Acceptances

30 persons.

<u>Note:</u> The School of Architecture, Art, and Design may accept a lower or greater number depending on the total number of qualified applicants.

# 2. Qualifications

2.1 Educational background

The applicant must satisfy at least one of the following requirements:

2.1.1 Graduated from or studying in Matthayom 6 or equivalent.2.1.2 Graduated from or studying in the final year of grade 12 (US system) or grade 13 (British/IB system) at an accredited college or higher-education institution in Thailand or abroad.

2.1.3 Obtained or expected to receive a qualification equivalent to Mathayom 6 or passed a high school equivalent standard test [GED, GCE 'A' Level], as approved by the Ministry of Education before the start of the Academic Year 2024.

2.1.4 The applicant must possess a history of good behavior and agree to abide strictly by existing and future KMITL regulations, codes, and policies.

## Remark:

# For the American System,

- General Educational Development (GED) Credential obtained before May 2017 requires a minimum total score of 2250 on all 5 subjects and at least 410 points on each subject, or
- General Educational Development (GED) Credential obtained after May 2017 requiring a minimum score of 145 on all 4 subjects and all 4 subjects have to "pass".

# For the British System,

- International General Certificate of Secondary Education (IGCSE), or General Certificate of Secondary Education (GCSE), or General Certificate of Education Ordinary Level (GCE O Level), with grade results A\*- C on 5 different subjects +transcript.
- And General Certificate of Education Advanced Level (GCE A-Level) with grade results A\*-E on at least 3 different subjects + transcript.

# New Zealand System,

- National Certificate of Educational Achievement (NCEA) Level 3 + Record of Achievement, or
- NCEA Level 2+ Record of Achievement: At least 80 credits achieved (60 credits at Level 2 or above + 20 credits at Level 1 or above), with English for speakers of other Languages (ESOL) considered as a subject, or At least 60 credits achieved on 5 different subjects at Level 2 or above, with at least 4 credits of English (Literacy) without English for speakers of other Languages (ESOL), and at least 4 credits of Mathematics (Numeracy) + Record of Achievement.

# International Baccalaureate Diploma Programme (IBDP)

- International Baccalaureate Diploma, or
- IB Diploma Course Results (IBCR) with at least grade 3 on at least 5 different subjects.

#### 2.2 Application Requirements

2.2.1 Two one-inch (1") photographs and a copy of your Thai citizen ID card or a copy of your passport pages.

2.2.2 Academic transcript(s); and in the case of high school completion, a copy of your Diploma from the school must also be submitted. In the case of currently being in the final year of high school, a copy of an official document certifying academic status from the applicant's school is also required.

2.2.3 The applicant should submit their test score from at least one of the following English proficiency tests:

**Remark:** If the applicant cannot fulfill the above requirement, he or she will be required to enroll in additional English as a Second Language (ESL) courses at KMITL, after admission to the Architecture (International program).

2.2.4 The applicant must submit a test score for at least one of the following Math tests.

- CU-AAT (Math)	550
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- SAT (Math) 570

- Mathematics on NCEA (New Zealand) Merit or Excellence Level

- Another internationally accredited standardized tests.

2.2.5 Personal Statement: Please submit a self-written essay (650words or less) that demonstrates your ability to communicate your thoughts and your related experience(s) in the field of study within the online application.

2.2.6 Two Recommendation Letters: the applicant should upload PDF or JPG snapshots of the letters of recommendation documents issued by academic advisors or teachers.

2.2.7 Portfolio: Personal works of art, craft, design, etc., collated into **one A4size PDF file (no page limitation).** The portfolio must only contain works created by the applicant; plagiarized information or work is not accepted and may lead to disqualification.

**Remark:** <u>Portfolio</u>; the purpose of the portfolio is to demonstrate the applicant's abilities as well as his / her organizational skills. The portfolio must demonstrate versatility in different areas of media such as sketching, painting, and photography. Architectural perspectives are not compulsory but will further reflect the applicant's skill of understanding the subject of architecture. Attention should be paid to the quality of reproduction. If original works are referenced, however, it is favored that applicants photograph the subject and create drawn media, via this method.

<u>The applicant must deposit a 500.00 baht non-refundable application fee</u> using one of the following payment methods after printing a payment slip from the Kasikorn bank from the application system.

1. Pay through any Bank applications by scanning the barcode (no fees) or

2. Pay at Kasikorn Bank counter available at all branches across the country. There is a bank fee of 10 baht. If paying via other bank counters, additional fees may apply.

(We reserve the right to refund the application fee in all cases and will not be responsible for any loss if payment is made by other methods.) **Note:** The applicant is responsible for any additional transaction fee incurred by financial institutions. If the applicant does not reside in Thailand, please contact our ADI admission office to facilitate the application process.

The applicant will be notified of his/her eligibility for an on-site interview after the admissions committee reviews that application. The actual location and time of the interview will be announced prior to the interview date.

Please bring the original documents to the interview.

- A photocopy of the applicant's national identification card or passport
- Academic Records High School Transcript, SAT, ACT, IB, GED, etc.,
- English Proficiency Test score IELTS, TOEFL, etc.,
- Two recommendation letters from teachers or supervisors (can be sealed and sent via email or posted by schools)
- Portfolios: provide a link to your portfolios or submit in the form of a pdf attached with your email to: interaffairs-aad@kmitl.ac.th.
  The applicant must bring their portfolios to the interview.
- Placement test results: submit available AP, IB Higher Level, A-Level, or any grade 12 equivalent placement test results. The policy and criteria for placement credits will be determined prior to the applicant's enrollment.
- Certificate of participation in any academic activities provided by the School of Architecture, Art, and Design KMITL
